Students experienced considerable disruption during Year 12 with large groups of students being placed in self-isolation for a period of 14 days due to positive covid 19 cases within our Sixth Form community. Students were also working from home for several weeks at a time.

Blended learning was adopted by all subjects, offering virtual lessons when not in the classroom. Although this was beneficial to the students this was not as comprehensive as face to face teaching and students may have missed areas of the Year 12 curriculum during this time.
