- 1st – 5th period = in der ersten (1st)/ zweiten (2nd)/ dritten (3rd)/ vierten (4th)/ fünften (5th) Stunde
2. The verb in a German sentence must be second position
3. e.g. Ich lerne Deutsch
4. e.g. Am Montag lerne ich Deutsch - Am Montag = first position
5. The WORD ORDER – where the pronoun is *after* the verb – is called **INVERSION**
6. An adjective = a describing word e.g. interessant (interesting)
7. An intensifier can come directly before an adjective to give a bit more detail
8. e.g. sehr interessant (very interesting)

1. Analogue time = when you use a traditional clock face

3. You need to be careful when saying half past using analogue time;
4. half past three = um halb vier (half way to 4 o'clock which is half past three!)
5. Digital time = when you use a digital clock face e.g. it is three thirty
6. The Germans use the twenty-four-hour clock
